Nursing Assistant

This course teaches skills for certification and employment as nursing assistants in long-term care facilities. Students learn to identify and meet basic patient care needs for safety comfort, and activities of daily living.

Phlebotomy Technician

Grace School of Nursing Phlebotomy Program prepares students for employment as phlebotomists.

Students learn skills including effective performance in obtaining adequate and correct blood specimens by capillary or venipuncture; Phlebotomists primarily draw blood, which is then used for different kinds of medical laboratory testing. In medical and diagnostic laboratories, patient interaction is sometimes only with the phlebotomist.

Patient Care Technician

This course is designed to ready students for the increasing responsibility and accountability of the technician level role in health care organizations. Concept and competencies of critical thinking informed consent, reliability, honesty, and ethics, will be covered. Students will be taught how to organize their work with independence and precision.



Practical Nurses (PN)

The objective of the program is to prepare students for employment as licensed practical nurses to care for ill, injured, or convalescing patients or persons with disabilities in hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, private homes, group homes in other health care settings.

Upon successful completion of the program, graduates can apply to and take the Florida State Board of Nursing examination (NCLEX-PN) for practical nurses and move on to the workforce.

Home Health Aide (HHA)

As a home health aide, you'll engage in a variety of tasks that canter around providing personal care and health-related services to patients who are unable to perform these tasks for themselves. You may also assist with clients' household chores, including laundry, light cleaning, and meal preparation.

Electrocardiograph Technician

Electrocardiograph technician, also known as an EKG technician, is an allied healthcare professional who uses specialized equipment to measure the heart's electrical activity. Physicians and other medical professionals can use this information to diagnose and treat a patient's cardiac health.
